

State Mandated CAsp Fee:

On September 19, 2012 Governor Brown signed into law SB-1186, which adds a state fee of \$1 to each application for a local business license or similar instrument or permit, or renewal thereof. On January 1, 2018 the fee was increased from \$1 to \$4 by AB-1379. The purpose is to increase disability access and compliance with construction-related accessibility requirements and to develop educational resources for businesses in order to facilitate compliance with federal and state disability laws, as specified.

Notice: Under federal and state law, compliance with disability access laws is a serious and significant responsibility that applies to all California building owners and tenants with buildings open to the public.
